### DEMOGRAPHICS

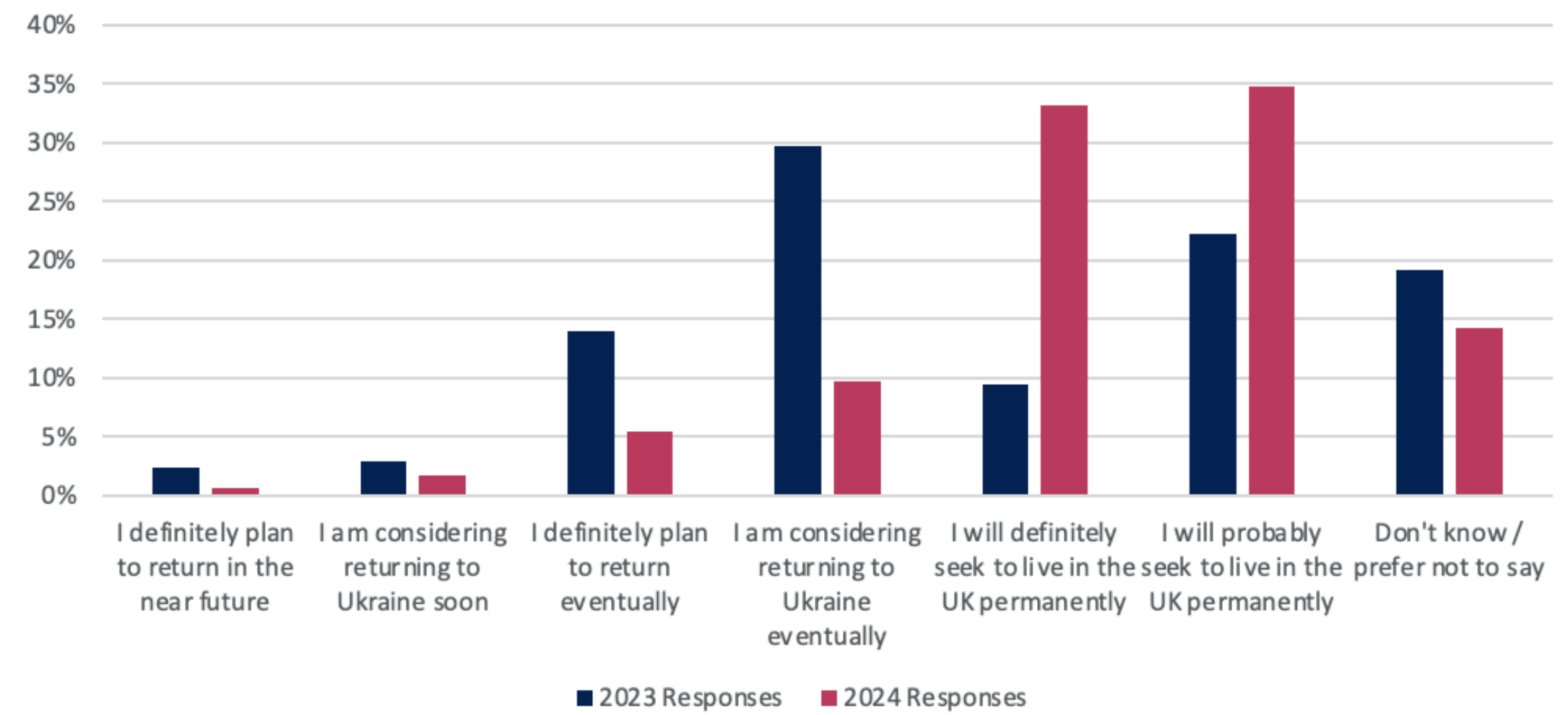
- 85% of respondents are female
- 59% are aged 35-44
- 80% of respondents are in the UK on the Homes for UK Scheme
- 69% of respondents have only 13-18 months left on their current visa
- 93% of respondents felt they received a warm welcome in the UK

### WORK

- 30% of respondents are in full-time work
- 5% of respondents are in the same level or higher level of job than before the war
- 28% of respondents are in lower level jobs
- 46% of respondents are proud to be able to work
- 34% of respondents are learning new skills
- 16% of respondents are feeling frustrated

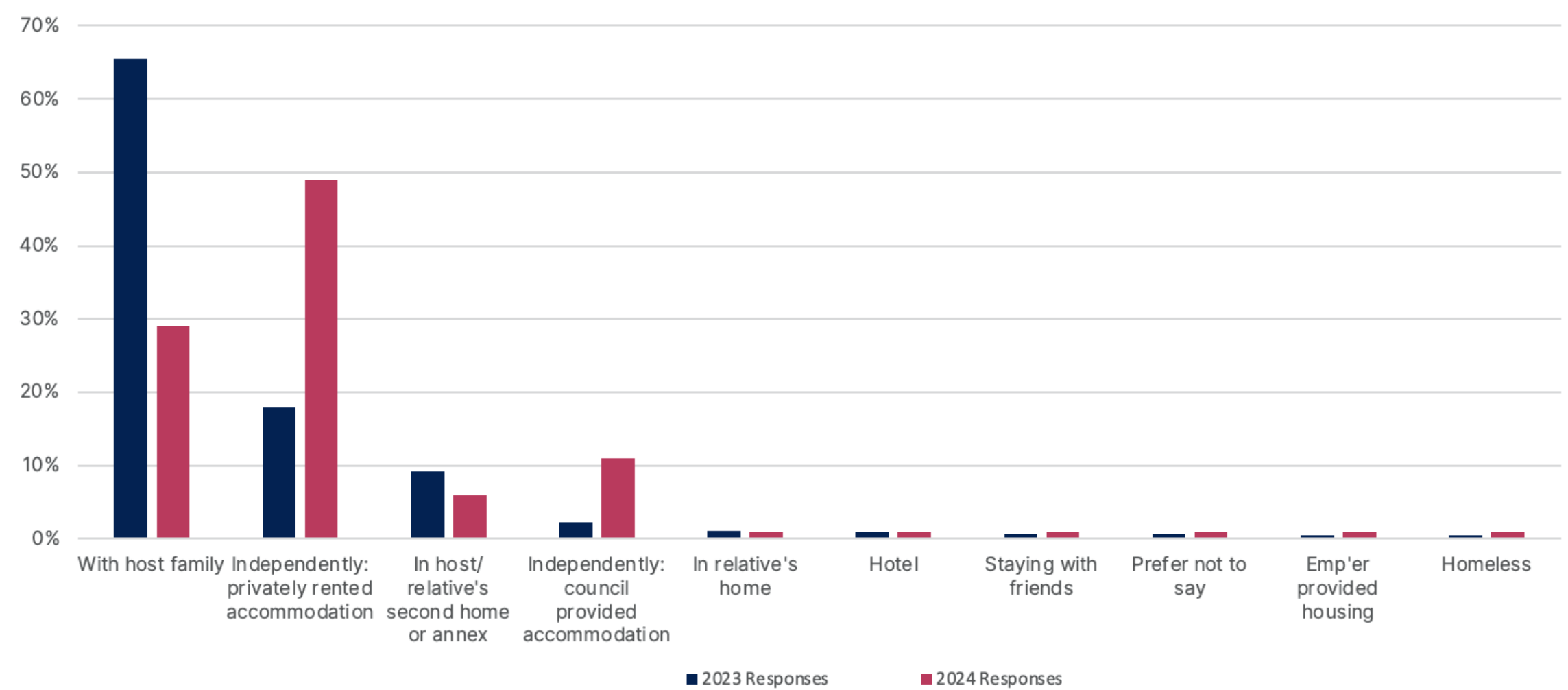
### FUTURE PLANS

#### WELCOME

Ukrainians continue to be very happy with how they have been welcomed to the UK.



#### HOUSING

Most Ukrainians have now moved on to living independently from their sponsors.



#### VISA

Ukrainians' main message to the UK government is to extend visas or give them a possibility of an Indefinite Leave to Remain.



#### RETURN TO UKRAINE

It appears that less Ukrainians are planning to return to Ukraine as time goes by.



#### DESIRE TO REBUILD UKRAINE

Many Ukrainians want to contribute to Ukraine's reconstruction but they need support and guidance to do this.

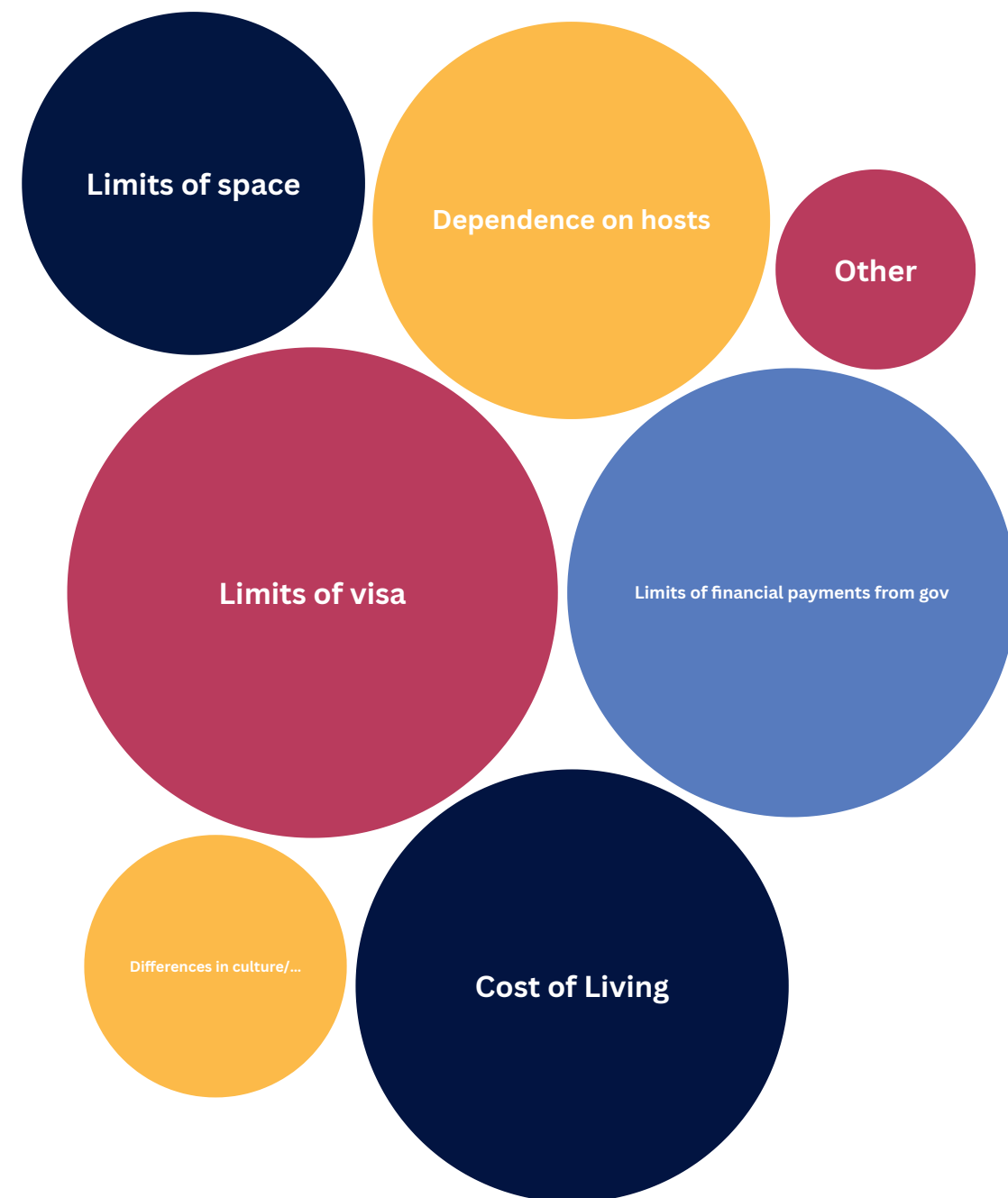

### CURRENT HOSTS

- 78% of current hosts have been hosting for over 12 months already
- Of those who share accommodation with their guests (425), 63% expect to provide accommodation for over 12 months
- 73% of hosts have a good/ excellent relationship with their guests
- 36% of hosts would host again with another 52% being open to considering hosting.

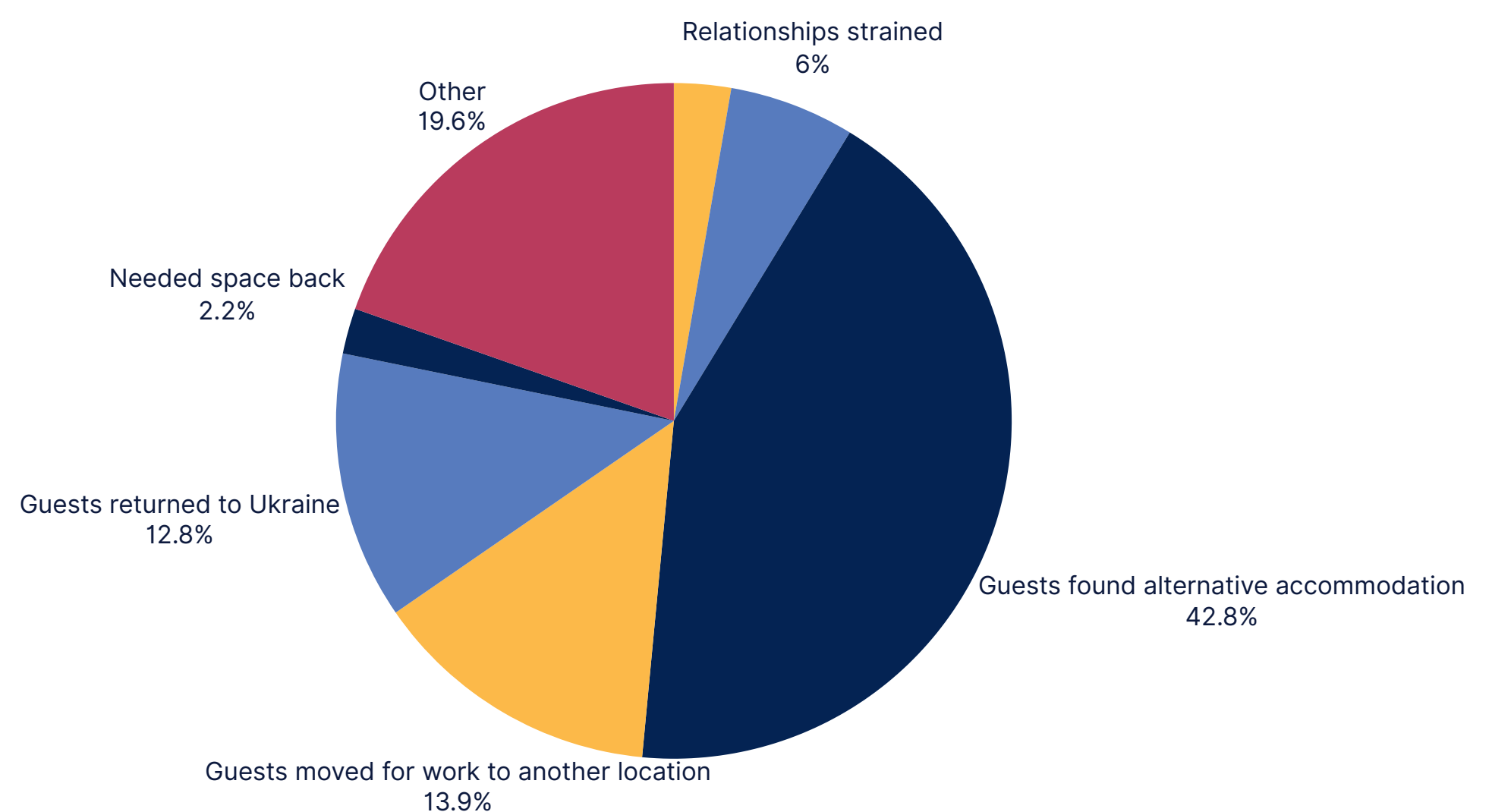
*Main concerns of continued hosting*



### FORMER HOSTS

- 31% of former hosts did so for over 12 months
- 26% of former hosts would host again with another 55% being open to considering hosting.
- 77% of former hosts still have an ongoing good/ excellent relationship with their former guests.

#### VISA UNCERTAINTY FOR UKRAINIANS
